Deliver an exceptional football scholarship programme that empowers students through education and football to realise their worth and importance and highlight the power they hold to impact both the teams' outcomes, and their personal journeys. Develop an understanding that football helps develop talent, dedication and leadership, shaping tomorrow's champions on and off the field.





The Programme

The TSF Partnership - Football Academy Football Scholarship Programme offered at Maltby Academy is a unique opportunity for talented 16–19-year-old footballers, to secure a pathway into semiprofessional football, whilst studying at a highly successful sixth form. The scholarship is an elite football development programme and ensures students access a first-class football experience, creating positive life-long memories and further their educational qualifications.

All players on the scholarship programme will undertake 3 A Levels and/or BTECs during the 2 years on the programme, with possible opportunities to acquire work-based qualifications such as the Introduction into Football Coaching and/or the FA Referee's Course. The students will access a high-quality football provision working with UEFA A and B coaches who have previously coached/played within the professional game.

The Offer

All those enrolled onto the scholarship programme undertake A Levels or applied qualifications alongside their football programme.

The scholarship provides students with:

- A football coaching programme delivered by UEFA A/B licenced coaches
- Training sessions that focus on technical/tactical detail, team/individual analysis, one-to-one development programme, alongside strength and conditioning

- Veo camera technology, recording all games
- Access to state-of-the-art training facilities, including an FA affiliated floodlit 3G pitch
- A comprehensive league and competition structure on Wednesday afternoons
- Scholarship pathways in America
- Opportunities to participate in overseas tours
- Work experience opportunities

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Our Facilities

All scholarship players have access to top class facilities in the Academy Sports Centre, supporting players to perform at the elite level. Video analysis is a massive part of our programme, reflecting on games and improving tactical understanding of the players. Our outstanding facilities allow us to invest in the physical development of our players, maximising plyometric, activation and weight training exercises.

Veo is an automated camera solution that enables sports teams to record and analyse matches and training sessions without the need for a camera operator. Veo films the whole pitch as once, and then uses AI to process the game, track the ball and automatically clip key events. All HD footage is upload to an online portal – which is easily accessed by players and coaches alike.

Overseas Football Tours:

On the scholarship programme we run an overseas football tour. Providing the students with an opportunity to play abroad is a great learning experience and an important tool in creating positive life-long memories. The scholars learn so much and benefit from playing and watching football of a different style and culture. We have recently visited Murcia, Barcelona and Dusseldorf as part of the football tour.

Progression Opportunities:

There are many different progression routes our scholars have taken following completion of their scholarship programme. We have developed players that are now playing regular Evo-Stick or NCEL Football whilst continuing their education through University in the UK and in the US as part of an overseas scholarship programme. Others are now enjoying full time employment drawing upon their experiences from the scholarship programme.

Sixth Form will be a new phase in your life and will feel different from your previous experiences.

Scholarship FAQS

How long is the course?

The course is generally a two year programme at The Sixth Form Partnership.

Who is it for?

It is for boys and girls who are between 16 - 18 years of age that want to further their knowledge, understanding and ability in football whilst at the same time gain a first class academic education.

What qualification will I gain?

The Sixth Form Partnership provides a broad range of specialist pathways from full academic A levels, to a mix of A levels and BTEC qualifications to fully vocational BTEC courses. This will depend on your previous qualifications at GCSE and your future career aspirations.

Where do I study?

You will study at both Maltby Academy and Sir Thomas Wharton Academy.

Where do I train?

You will train at Maltby Academy using the new 3rd generation astro-turf; strength and conditioning studio; fitness suite and video analysis suite.

What type of training will I receive to help me progress?

Training will be based on improving you as players on ALL aspects of the game, with sessions concentrating on a players technique, tactical, psychological and social development. This may also involve footage of your very own Scholarship games that will be played back to you in our analysis sessions to aid further player development.

Who will be teaching me?

Fully qualified teachers will be responsible for delivering your chosen academic or vocational courses, whilst our licensed coaches, who have experience in professional and semi-professional settings, will provide your football coaching and development.

Do I get a kit?

As part of the TSF Partnership Scholarship programme, it is compulsory that all players purchase our kit package. The total cost of the kit package is subsidised. All scholarship players must wear their TSF Partnership kit for both training and match days. The kit will be given to players when they start on the programme in September.

Can I still play for a Local Football Club if I am on the scholarship?

The scholarship programme is delivered between 8am and 5pm, Monday - Friday, so does not affect the opportunity for students to participate with local football clubs.
